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Sale Terms & Conditions (commitment to purchase a specific goat)

- The down payment to hold does, wethers (already wethered/being sold as wethers only) and bucks is \$50.00, and is *non refundable unless the goat would sicken or die while at Barakah Heritage Farm (BHF) or BHF cancels the contract.*
- We do not routinely disbud. We offer polled (naturally hornless) kids when available.
- Down payments are due when you commit to purchase the goat (when you sign the contract) by PayPal, cash, Zelle, Cash App, or postal money order. No “time payments” without prior arrangement.
- Final payment must be paid in full via PayPal, cash, postal money order, Zelle, or Cash App before the goat leaves Barakah Heritage Farm.
- The price of the goat includes registration. Registration is completed by Oak Hill and buyer provided with certificate plus signed transfer paperwork. Buyer will need to join Myotonic Goat Registry to transfer the papers. If registration is pending, completed certificate and transfer paperwork will be mailed to the buyer. Current processing time for new registrations is up to 4 months and longer during spring kidding season. Processing time is outside of our control.
- Goats can be picked up at three months of age or later. The pick up date will be mutually agreed upon at the time of the purchase agreement.
- If the goat is not picked up within a week of the agreed upon date the buyer will pay board of \$2.00 per day and any medical costs.
- The Buyer is responsible for the cost of:
 - Transportation
 - **IMPORTANT NOTE ON TRANSPORTATION:** All goats must be transported in an *adequately sized*, covered, ventilated, safe vehicle, where they may comfortably, and safely, stand, turn around and lay down. The buyer must inform Barakah Heritage Farm of how the goats will be transported *before* the pick up date. If the buyer shows up to pick up the goats with what Barakah Heritage Farm determines to be unsatisfactory and/or unsafe transportation, Barakah Heritage Farm retains the right to refuse to release the goats until approved transportation is provided.
 - Veterinary Health Certificate (Optional)
 - Fee charged by the Vet for a farm call
 - Plus Vet fee per animal
 - Please note that a vet certificate is legally required for any travel outside of South Carolina

Purchase Package:

Purchase includes online access to goat care portions of The Energetic Goat book, downloadable support materials and all consultations as described on the website. See website for the exact package.

Doeling buyers may bring their doe back to BHF once per year for breeding to one of our bucks at no charge. To be eligible for this, the buyer must show proof that ALL adult goats in their herd have negative CAE/CL/Johnes tests no more than 30 days prior to the planned breeding. BHF reserves the right to cancel a breeding if the doe arrives sick or with obvious signs of disease.

Other Information:

- Our kids are dam-raised when possible. We rarely sell bottle babies. Kids may be shy at first.
- We currently have no known health problems. Nevertheless, we *do not* guarantee our goats are CAE/Johnes/CL free or free of any other diseases or health problems. We CAN guarantee that all adult goats have been tested regularly for CAE/Johnes/CL, and the testing certificate is posted publicly on our website and Facebook page.
- Goats are herd animals and will be very unhappy if you just have one; they need the company of their own kind. Because we care about our goats, we will not sell just one goat to anyone unless they already have goats.
- Males are neutered (wethered) using a burdizzo, which causes the testicles to atrophy. Sterility is within days. However full atrophy may take 3 months and the wether will retain a small scrotum for life. If atrophy fails to occur by 4 months from the neutering date, Barakah Heritage Farm will re-neuter the goat for you at our cost.
- We reserve the right to not sell our goat to any potential buyer. If Barakah Heritage Farm declines the sale, the fees, including the deposit, are refunded. Deposit for wethers is not refundable.
- Fainting behavior (myotonia) varies by diet, weather and other factors. Barakah Heritage Farm does not guarantee the frequency/intensity of fainting (myotonia) in our fainting kids. If fainting pictures are available for a specific goat, copies will be provided to the buyer. MGR will accept goats with the degree of myotonia varying from no obvious myotonia to mild stiffening to frequent full fainting, provided other characteristics are consistent with the breed standard.

By sending a deposit or down payment along with a signed copy of this document, the buyer agrees to, and is bound by, the terms and conditions laid out on this page.
